We feel that the funding will be sufficient to partially support a deserving student through the entirety of a four-year college program assuming satisfactory annual progress and continuing interest in those disciplines. The study will need to be conducted at an accredited four year school in the state of Colorado, and the student must be a resident of the Rotary District within which the University Hills Rotary Club lies.
