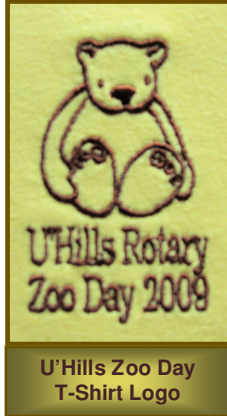


# The Spirit of U'Hills 15 May 2009

Now, back to the present:



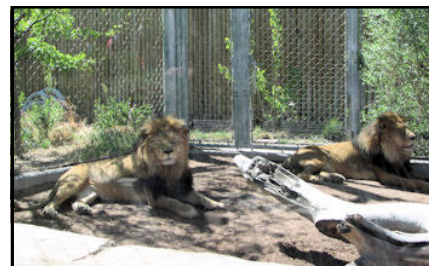
OK. What did we do? Well, just down to the right we saw:
